Ever wanted to learn how to save a life? With our American Red Cross lifeguard certification course, you can do just that. Participants will learn lifeguarding skills with waterfront module, how to perform CPR on an adult, child and infant, how to use an AED, and necessary first-aid skills. Upon successful course completion, participants will be certified in American Red Cross Lifeguarding and Waterfront Module, American Red Cross CPR/AED for the Lifeguard, and American Red Cross Basic First Aid.

- Must be at least 15 years old by end of class
- Must attend & pass Free Pre-Course Swim Test
- Class participants will receive a CPR resuscitation mask and whistle.
- Lifeguard opportunities at the Y's Pittsfield & Northern Berkshire Branches, BCC, Berkshire Hills, Windsor Lake
