Medical Information Required:

- ✓ Proof of physical exam & immunizations (from the past 12 months)
- ✓ Individual Health Care Plan (for allergies, chronic conditions, medications)
- ✓ Consent for YMCA staff to apply sunscreen & bug spray
- **Emergency Contacts:** Three non-parent/guardian are required. If we can't reach a parent/guardian, we will follow your emergency authorization plan.
