SUMMER PROGRAM GROUPS:

- Pioneers: Entering 1st grade
 - Our youngest children begin the Summer Program experience with the excitement of trying new things!

- **Explorers**: Entering 2nd grade

SUMMER PROGRAM TRANSPORTATION:

- There is no bus transportation.

 - Parents must accompany children into the building to be dropped off.
 - Per EEC guidelines, COVID-19 Daily Health Screening must be completed each day for each child at drop off.

IS YOUR FAMILY TRAVELING THIS SUMMER?

Per Massachusetts COVID-19 prevention guidelines, families traveling out of state or out of country may not return to Summer Program until they either a) provide a negative COVID test OR b) quarantine for 10 days.

EMERGENCY CONTACTS:

Three emergency contacts are required. Every effort will be made to contact a parent/guardian in the event of an emergency requiring medical attention for your child. However, if you or one of the three listed emergency contacts cannot be reached, per your registration form, you will authorize the program to transport your child to the nearest medical care facility to secure necessary medical treatment for your child.

PROVIDE CHILD HEALTH INFORMATION

- Proof of medical physical and immunizations by licensed physician within the last 12 months is required.
- Children with allergies must include individual health care plan and medication consent.
- Provide details of child's sensitivities (i.e.: food, sensory, noise, etc.) and helpful tips.
- Children with chronic health conditions must include individual health care plan and medication consent.
- YMCA staff must be authorized (indicated on Summer Program registration form) to apply sunscreen for my child.

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE (FA):

The Berkshire Family YMCA offers Financial Assistance for children to participate in summer day Summer Program. Eligibility is based on household size and income. Applications for Financial Assistance can be downloaded from our website – bfymca.org – or picked up the Welcome Center of either branch location. The Y reserves the right to

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deny or discontinue service at any time. Applications for Financial Assistance MUST be received at least two weeks prior to first Summer Program week. Financial Aid is given on a first-come, first-served basis to qualified families. Vouchers are also accepted.

• FA Eligibility

- Families must work or reside in the Y service area.
- Assistance will be granted on financial need for low income on a first-come first-serve basis.
- Financial assistance is for the current Summer Program year only.
- Prior account balances must be paid in full before applying.

FA How to Apply

- Applications must be filled out completely. See complete details on Financial Assistance Packet.
- Federal tax form and one month of current pay stubs or other form of income (SSI, food stamps, etc.) must be submitted.
- Copies of documentation must be provided.
- A registration fee of \$25 is required for NEW registrants in order to process an application. This is a non-refundable deposit if you decide not to attend the Summer Program.
- Applicants will be notified by mail of their award.

PAYMENT INFORMATION:

- Make all checks payable to the Berkshire Family YMCA, 292 North Street, Pittsfield, MA 01201.
- Summer Program fees must be paid in full the Friday before the week of Summer Program by check or automatic EFT from a bank account or credit card. Put your child's name on the check.
- Full Voucher or Partial Voucher with parent fee accepted.
- After the program has met twice, no credits or refunds will be issued.
- There will be a fee of \$1 per minute for children who are picked up after 5:30pm. Please note that after Summer Program care ends promptly at 5:30pm.
- Payments accepted at the YMCA only, not at Summer Program.
