- Develops and maintains professional relationships and models professional boundaries with families.
- Transports children before and after family time if needed.
- Documents family time for participating families in an unbiased manner.
- Ability to uphold confidentiality in a multitude of environments.
- Attend all staff meetings and in-service training
- All other duties assigned by management
